

REGULATIONS 2025

- 1. CLUB DE AUTOMOVILISMO ACTION PRESS, MYTIME, ESCUDERIA LA CORUÑA, NEW WAVE will organize in 2025 an initiative called the **Iberian Eco Rally Challenge (IERC)**, which is governed by these regulations.
- 2. This competition includes the four eco rallies in Spain and Portugal that count for the Bridgestone FIA ecoRally Cup 2025.
- 3. There will be one classification for drivers and another for co-drivers. The score for each of them in each event will be the one assigned by the FIA in the Bridgestone FIA ecoRally Cup, removing the special coefficient (1.5) from the Madeira event.
 - a) All drivers and co-drivers who participate in each of the events can qualify, regardless of their nationality.
 - b) To qualify, they must participate in at least one rally in Spain and one in Portugal.
 - c) The first three drivers and co-drivers to finish will be awarded prizes.
 - d) In the event of a tie, the winner will be the one who achieved the most first places, then the one who achieved the most second places, and so on. If the tie persists, the winner will be the one who achieved the best classification in the first race held.
- 4. The organization may award trophies with the name of a sponsor.
- 5. All official documents of the trophy and its results will be published on the websites of the organizers.
- 6. Any modification to these regulations will be published on the websites of the organizers. In case of doubts, they will be resolved by the jury of this competition and their decisions will be final.
- 7. The jury of the trophy is composed of a representative of each of the organizers: CLUB DE AUTOMOVILISMO ACTION PRESS, MYTIME, ESCUDERIA LA CORUÑA and NEW WAVE.
